PMIEF Grant to MBA *Research* brings PM Curriculum to 70 teachers, 1500 youth

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During the recent teacher training taking place in Nevada, USA, enthusiastic teachers posed with their PMBOK guides.

PMIEF recently awarded a grant to MBA Research & Curriculum Center ("MBA Research"), a nonprofit organization that supports educators to prepare students for careers in business and marketing. The grant will enable PMIEF to integrate project management into Career and Technical Education ("CTE") secondary school classes across the U.S. by delivering training to 70 secondary school teachers this summer. The training will prepare teachers to engage their students in hands-on, project management-rich curricula during the 2015-16 school year. This initiative is expected to reach 1,500 to 2,000 youth.

PMIEF has long recognized that CTE is a viable entry point into secondary school education through which the foundation can achieve its Vision-Driven Project, which strives to prepare PM-Knowledgeable Youth in keeping with PMIEF's core strategic goals.

CTE courses offer project-based, experiential learning opportunities that prepare young people for college and career in the 21st century. PMIEF's partnership with MBA Research began in 2012 with a national study to determine secondary schools' perceived value of project management. The study revealed teachers' interest in adding project management to their existing coursework, so PMIEF collaborated with MBA Research to create project management curricula for secondary school business, finance and marketing classes. With this grant, that curricula can be implemented across the U.S.

MBA Research is facilitating four teacher training workshops across the U.S. this summer in Missouri, Nevada, North Carolina and Ohio. Stay tuned for more updates as this grant continues to progress in the coming months!
