# Apply Now for PMIEF Scholarships and Awards

Each year, the PMI Educational Foundation (PMIEF) provides project management-related academic and professional development scholarships and awards to more than 200 individuals. These scholarships and awards, made possible through the generous support of PMI, PMI chapters, corporations and individuals, help develop the best and brightest future project managers.

## Academic Scholarships—Applications Due 1 May

The Academic Scholarship Program is designed to support qualified individuals in obtaining undergraduate and graduate degrees in project management and project management-related degree programs.

PMIEF currently administers over 50 academic scholarships. This includes individual cash scholarships valued between US\$1,000 and US\$7,500 that can be used for an approved academic degree program at an accredited college or university of the recipient's choice, as well as full to partial scholarships at the University of Management and Technology (UMT). Each scholarship has specific eligibility requirements, which can be viewed by visiting the scholarship section of the PMIEF website, [pmief.org](http://pmief.org).

While each scholarship has its own criteria, for most academic scholarships an applicant only needs to complete one application, the Academic Application for Undergraduates and Graduates. PMIEF will match all applicants to the scholarship(s) criteria for which they are eligible. Some scholarships are based on geographic location, while others are

available to be awarded to any applicant living or attending a university anywhere in the world.

Students interested in an associate, master's or doctoral degree from University of Management and Technology may apply using the UMT Technology Scholarship Program for U.S. Public High School Seniors and Graduates or the University of Management and Technology Application.

The deadline to apply for all academic scholarships is **1 May 2017**.

## Awards

Applications are due **20 May** for The Community Advancement Through Project Management Award, which recognizes pro bono/skilled volunteer project management contributions that transfer project management skills to a nonprofit or nongovernmental organization (NGO) and thus increase their capacity to accomplish their mission. The award is separated into three different categories: Corporations/Government Agencies,

Individual Project Managers and PMI Chapters. Those in each category completing projects from 1 January 2014 to 20 May 2017 are eligible. The PMI Chapter Category is sponsored by Hewlett Packard Enterprise. The application deadline is **20 May 2017**.

Applications are due **15 May** for The Kerzner Award for Excellence in Project Management, which is sponsored by the International Institute for Learning, Inc. (IIL) to recognize a project manager who most emulates the professional dedication and excellence of Harold Kerzner, MS, MBA, PhD. In addition to public recognition of his or her professional dedication and excellence, the recipient of the Kerzner Award will receive IIL training. The total value of the training, including a US\$2,500 cash prize and a trip to PMI® Global Conference, is up to US\$13,000. The application deadline is **15 May 2017**.
